Posting Scores: We will post scores for you on the week's where the format allows
Format: 2 Person Team Play (various 2 person formats) - Pairings will be made weekly so that everyone plays with one another at least one time.

## Couples League Local Rules

## Mens - White Tees |Mens 70+ - Green Tees $\mid$ Ladies - Gold Tees

1. Preferred Lies up-to 12 " in your own fairway. Mark, lift, clean \& place
2. There is no out-of-bounds on property
a. If you hit a ball in an area not clearly marked by red or yellow hazard please play a provisional ball. This way you won't have to go back to the tee to re-tee.
3. All hazards are clearly marked
4. Utilize the Drop Zones over the Cross Hazards on \#7, \#11, \#18 if a ball goes into hazard.
5. If a player's ball lies against or when the following conditions apply, the ball may be lifted and dropped within 1 club length of nearest point of full relief, no closer to the hole, without penalty:

- Cart paths (paved or gravel)
- Cart path extensions (to be determined by a vote within group/ foursome)
- Newly sod areas, and white out-lined ground under repair areas
- Tree Stumps or area of tree stump removal

6. The port-o-potties (\#4 \& \#14) are immovable obstructions; proper relief may be taken without penalty.
7. Small rocks (penny size or bigger) may be lifted (by hand) out of any bunker without penalty.
8. The bridges on holes \#3, \#5, \#7, \&\#18 are considered part of the hazard.
9. Yardage makers are measured to the center of the green.
10. The use of Range finders is approved as long as they do not measure other conditions (e.g., gradient, slope, wind speed and temperature, etc.).
11. The Oaks Pace Of Play policy is $2: 15$ minutes per 9 holes - should your group fall behind pace, an Oaks employee will approach your group and ask you to speed up to regain proper pace of play.

May $2^{\text {nd }}$ - Couples Scramble - Gross \& Net | Back 9
Each couple will tee off, choose the better of the two tee shots, and then all hit from there. Continue this process through the end of the hole and add up the total amount of shots. Each 2-person team will only have 1 score per hole and turn in 1 scorecard. We will determine Gross \& Net winners calculate using a percentage of the handicaps.
Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#13 Mens \& Women | Closest to Pin \#16 COED
May 9 ${ }^{\text {th }}-$ Couples Best Odd Holes | Front 9
All players will play their own ball and turn in their own scorecard. Only the ODD holes will count for scoring. We will score this as a Best Ball format between each couple. Payouts will also be Gross \& Net. Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#3 COED | Closest to Pin \#5 Men \& Women

May $16^{\text {th }}-$ Couples Best Ball of 2 Gross \& Net | Back 9
All players will play their own ball and turn in their own scorecard. We will score this as a Best Ball format between each couple. Payouts will also be Gross \& Net.
Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#13 COED | Closest to Pin \#16 Men \& Women
May $23^{\text {rd }}$ - Couples Team Point Quota | Front 9
Each couple will play their own ball. Based on your handicap, each individual will have a certain number of points to get. We will add each Couples individual point total to get a Team Quota. The point system is as followed; Birdie (4 points), Par ( 2 points), Bogey ( 1 point), Double Bogey or worse ( 0 points).
Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#3 Men \& Women | Closest to Pin \#5 COED
May 30 ${ }^{\text {th }}-$ Couples Bramble - Gross \& Net | Back 9
Each couple will tee off, choose the better of the two tee shots, and then each person plays their own ball from the $2^{\text {nd }}$ shot position. Score is Best Ball of 2 Gross \& Net.
Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#13 Mens \& Women | Closest to Pin \#16 COED
June $6^{\text {th }}$ - Couples Odds and Evens - Gross \& Net | Front 9
One partners score counts on the Even \# Holes and the other on the Odd \# holes. Gross \& Net Winners Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#3 COED | Closest to Pin \#5 Men \& Women

June $\mathbf{1 3}^{\text {th }}$ - Couples Scramble - Gross \& Net | Back 9
Each couple will tee off, choose the better of the two tee shots, and then all hit from there. Continue this process through the end of the hole and add up the total amount of shots. Each 2-person team will only have 1 score per hole and turn in 1 scorecard. We will determine Gross \& Net winners calculate using a percentage of the handicaps.
Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#13 COED | Closest to Pin \#16 Men \& Women
June 20 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ - Throw Out 3 Worst Holes Couples Scramble | Front 9
Each team will tee off, choose the better of the two tee shots, and then all hit from there. Continue this process through the end of the hole and add up the total amount of shots. Each 2-person team will only have 1 score per hole and turn in 1 scorecard. We will determine Gross \& Net winners calculated using a percentage of the combined handicaps. Your best 6 holes to par will count.
Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#3 Men \& Women | Closest to Pin \#5 COED

June $\mathbf{2 7}^{\text {th }}$ - Modified Alternate Shot - Gross \& Net | Back 9
Each couple will tee off, choose the better of the two tee shots, and then alternate from there. 1 score per hole and turn in 1 scorecard. We will determine Gross \& Net winners calculate using a percentage of the handicaps.
Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#13 Mens \& Women | Closest to Pin \#16 COED
July $4^{\text {th }}-$ No League Due to Holiday
July 11 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ - Couples Bramble - Gross \& Net $\mid$ Front 9
Each couple will tee off, choose the better of the two tee shots, and then each person plays their own ball from the $2^{\text {nd }}$ shot position. Score is Best Ball of 2 Gross \& Net.
Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#3 COED | Closest to Pin \#5 Men \& Women
July $\mathbf{1 8}^{\text {th }}$ - Couples Best Ball of 2 Gross \& Net | Back 9
All players will play their own ball and turn in their own scorecard. We will score this as a Best Ball format between each couple. Payouts will also be Gross \& Net.
Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#13 COED | Closest to Pin \#16 Men \& Women
July 25 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ - Couples Team Point Quota $\mid$ Front 9
Each couple will play their own ball. Based on your handicap, each individual will have a certain number of points to get. We will add each Couples individual points to get a Team Quota. The point system is as followed; Birdie (4 points), Par ( 2 points), Bogey (1 point), Double Bogey or worse (0 points).
Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#3 Men \& Women | Closest to Pin \#5 COED
August 1 ${ }^{\text {st }}$ - Couples Best Ball of 2 Gross \& Net |Back 9
All players will play their own ball and turn in their own scorecard. We will score this as a Best Ball format between each couple. Payouts will also be Gross \& Net.
Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#13 Mens \& Women | Closest to Pin \#16 COED
August 8 ${ }^{\text {th }}-$ Couples Best Even Holes | Front 9
All players will play their own ball and turn in their own scorecard. Only the EVEN holes will count for scoring. We will score this as a Best Ball format between each couple. Payouts will also be Gross \& Net. Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#3 COED | Closest to Pin \#5 Men \& Women

August 15 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ - Modified Alternate Shot - Gross \& Net |Back 9
Each couple will tee off, choose the better of the two tee shots, and then alternate from there. 1 score per hole and turn in 1 scorecard. We will determine Gross \& Net winners calculate using a percentage of the handicaps.
Contest Holes: Closest to Pin \#13 Mens \& Women | Closest to Pin \#16 COED
August 22 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ - End of Season Couples Scramble | Front 9
Each couple will tee off, choose the better of the two tee shots, and then all hit from there. Continue this process through the end of the hole and add up the total amount of shots. Each 2-person team will only have 1 score per hole and turn in 1 scorecard. We will determine Gross \& Net winners calculate using a percentage of the combined handicaps
